have noticed that the lack of SFPD patrols which is due to staffing limitations. As a result I have been fielding queries on the feasibility of having a private security patrol at night. I am told that we did have such a service many years ago. You may also have read that neighbors in the Marina have banded together to hire such a service. What is not as well known is that there is only one that is authorized by the City Charter to patrol public streets and directly interact with SFPD. It is the oldest unit in the country and dates back to 1847. The SF Patrol Special Police is managed by the Police Commission to provide a neighborhood patrolling service, checking in with the precinct before and after shifts. They are armed and use patrol cars but can only make citizen arrests.

Your board would like to gauge the interest in engaging such a service and have set up an email address, safety@ithasf.org where you can express it. Such service generally runs between \$50 to \$65 a month for overnight patrols (8pm – 5am) depending on participation. You can review the services that are offered on their website at http://www.sf-patrolspecpolice.com. Please note that this would not be funded by your HOA dues unless we as a neighborhood voted to make our dues mandatory and factored that into the yearly amount. I have also started a discussion in our Terraces Forum at http://forum.ithasf.org for us to share thoughts and questions.
